Dear Resident,

On August 1, 2011, construction will begin, in your area, on the project known as the North Drainage Outfall. This project is replacing the dilapidated corrugated metal pipe that is currently in place between the former PAFB South Housing Area and South Patrick Park subdivision to the north and the School Board, Villa Sienna and other properties to the south.

The current drainage system outfalls to the Grand Canal via pipes located between the South Waterway Sub-Division and homes and town-homes located on the north side of Chevy Chase Boulevard and Mark and Randy Drive. The new system will cross under SR 513 at Chevy Chase Boulevard and outfall into the east end of the Chevy Chase canal.

In order to facilitate the new system, drainage pipes and 2 nutrient separating baffle boxes will be installed in westbound lane of Chevy Chase Boulevard. The baffle boxes will also assist in the prevention of sedimentary material reaching the canal and ultimately the Indian River Lagoon.

During the construction period vehicular traffic will need to be re-routed around the work area. All detours will be clearly marked and flagmen will be provided. Residents will have access to their homes at all times, although there may be some minor delays. ***If you are a special needs resident, please advise Public Works immediately to insure that any necessary arrangements can be made.***

The Contractor, Masci Corporation of Port Orange, Fl., expects this portion of the project to take 2 weeks, barring weather or equipment delays. During construction, a Satellite Beach Public Works representative will be present to address any concerns by residents.

Where applicable, any vegetation or irrigation systems that will need to be disturbed or removed will be replaced in kind.

This project was funded by a FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant, which will pay 75% of the costs. In accordance with an interlocal agreement, the remaining 25% will be divided between the City, Brevard County and the Brevard County School Board.

Dear Resident,

Due to the construction that will begin on August 1, 2011, re-routing of vehicular traffic will be necessary. The westbound lane of Chevy Chase Boulevard will be closed for pipe installation. During the construction period, the eastbound lane of Chevy Chase Boulevard will be temporarily striped to accommodate both east and westbound vehicles.

In order to insure the proper vehicle clearance for this detour, parking will be prohibited on either side of Chevy Chase Boulevard. This is a temporary situation. There will be "No Parking" signs installed along the roadway until the detours are removed. Once construction is complete, the "No Parking" signs will be removed.
