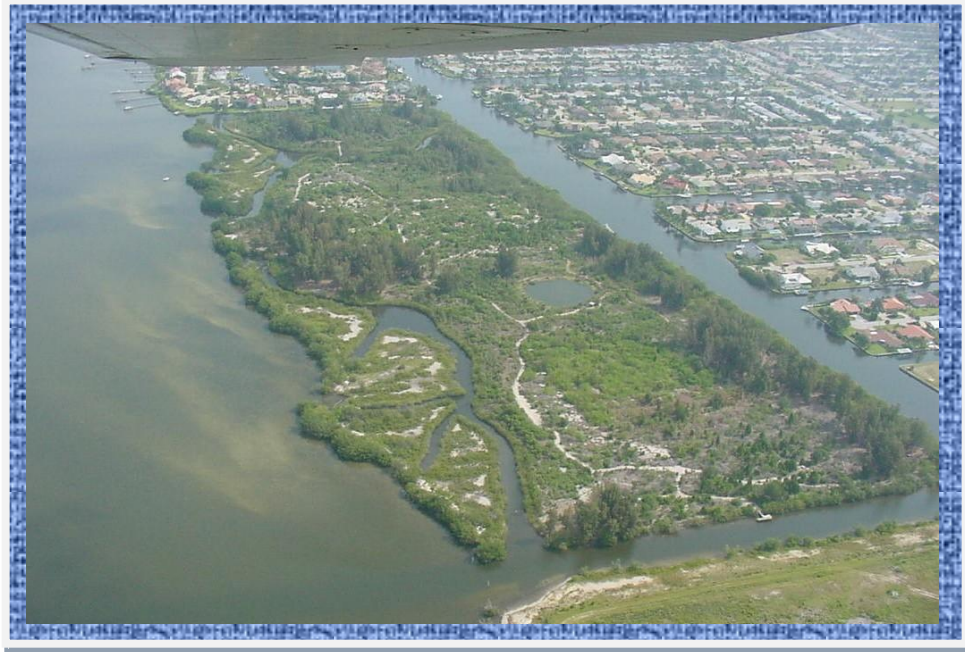


Samsons Island Park



Samsons Island is the City's first "Environmental Showcase," having been renovated from an island overrun with exotic plants. Volunteers have worked diligently since 1991 to provide our community with this unique park, unlike any other in Brevard County. Samsons Island is only accessible by boat, thereby limiting the impact humans have on the preserve setting.

Free public boat transportation is offered on specific days, and is a wonderful opportunity to visit the island park or volunteer to help with park ranger-type duties. There is no charge to visit Samsons Island, but if you plan to be on the park after dark, a permit is required, which can be obtained at the City's Recreation Department.

Primitive camping, bird watching, geocaching, and nature photography are but a few of the treasures in store for you on Samsons Island.
